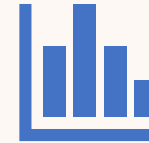

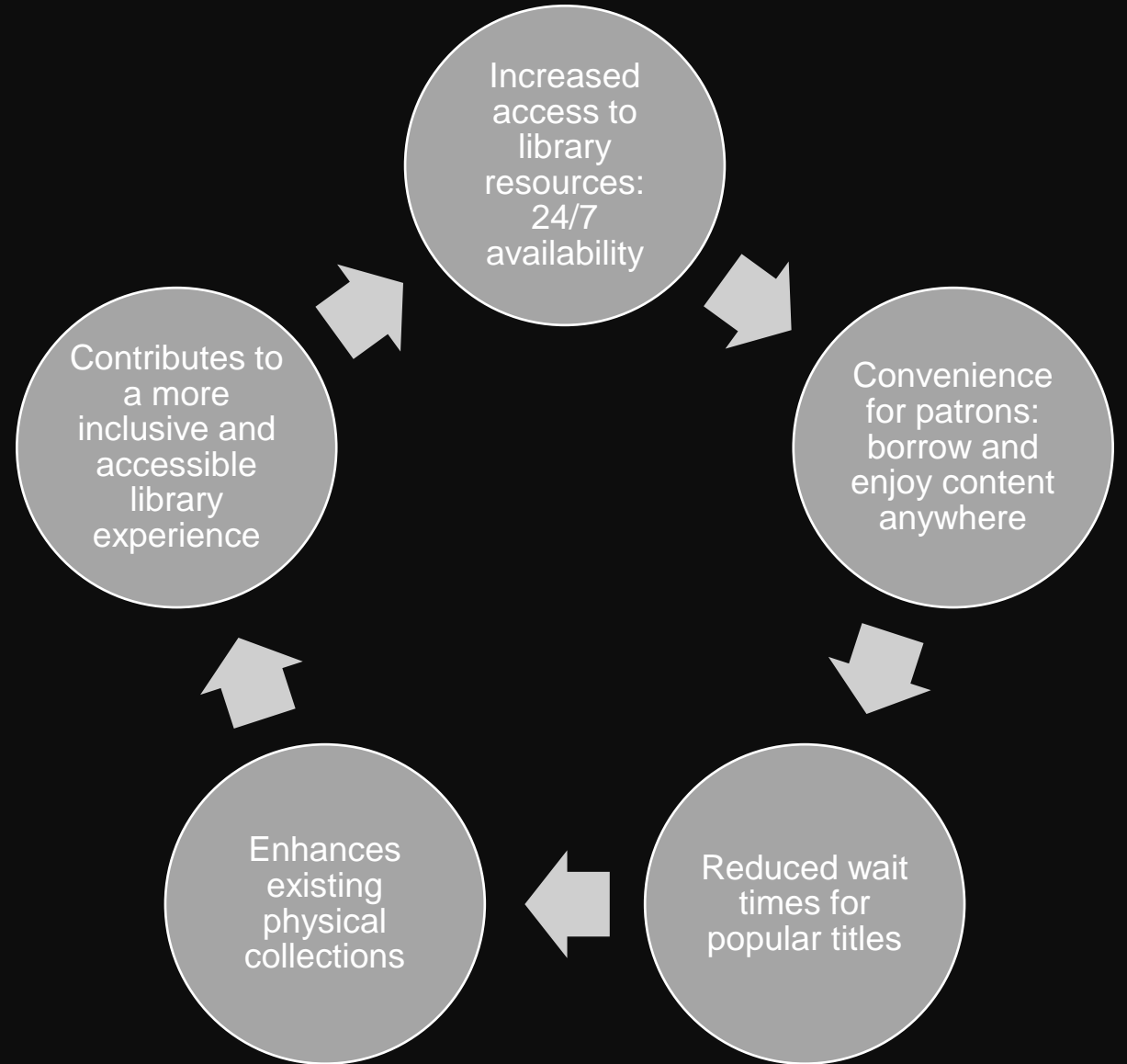



Getting started with Kanopy

- Signing up for Kanopy is easy! Simply visit our library's website and click on the Kanopy link <https://www.kanopy.com/en/ndsl>
 - Patrons will be directed to the Kanopy registration page, where they can enter library card information or find their local library.
 - Libraries that don't have a 14-digit library card will need to direct patrons to use an NDSL card
 - Once registered, patrons have unlimited access to Kanopy's entire collection.

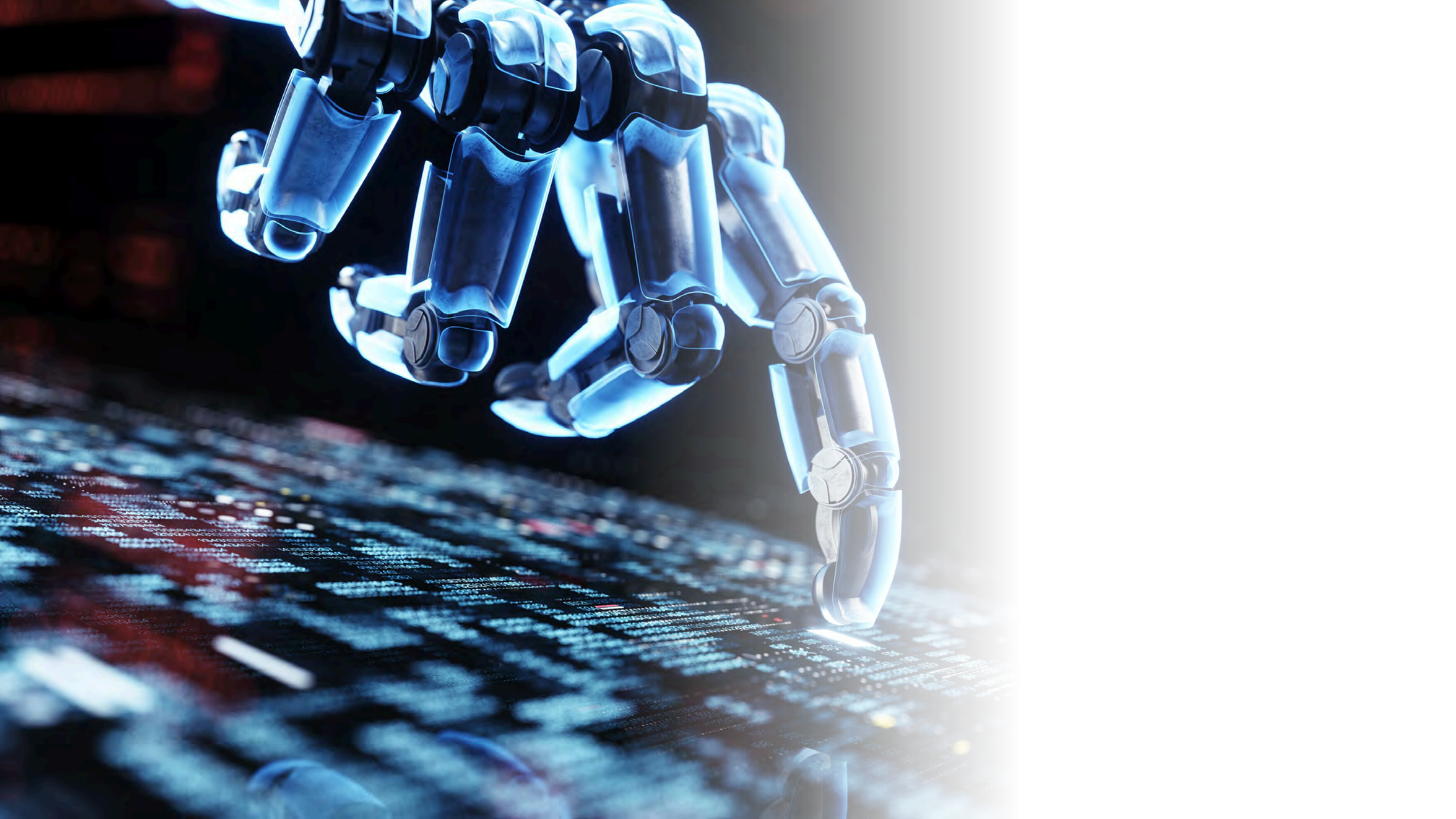
