guide to the function of each
section of *In English*

The Complete *In English* curriculum consists of 20 videos or DVDs and five workbooks. Volume 1 of *In English*, called *In English On Your Own*, consists of 12 videos/DVDs covering 4 Units. These Units contain all of the sections outlined below.

Volumes 2-5 of *In English* (Units 5-12) DVDs/videos consist of only the four sections marked with this symbol. They do not contain the workbook exercises or any repetition. Learners know what is required in Volumes 2 through 5, modeling on what they learned from Volume 1.

S **SCENE** introduces the new sentence structure and vocabulary of each Unit. The learner's task is to view the Scene and determine how much of it they understand.

V **P** **The VOCABULARY** section presents the vocabulary shown in the Scene in visual, captioned and spoken context. The learner's task is to review the vocabulary until they learn it. The **PRONUNCIATION** section of the video/DVD consists of all the Vocabulary for pronunciation practice.

QUESTIONS presents questions about the Scene. The **QUESTION** numbers correspond to the numbers shown in blue triangles on the video/DVD Scene section. The learner's task is to review the video until they can answer all the question orally and then in written form.

STRUCTURE presents the key grammar points in **bold** taught in each Unit. The learner's task is to listen and repeat to reinforce the grammar patterns.

The WRITING section is exercises for practice with the grammar and vocabulary of the Unit. The learner's task is to write the answers in their workbook and to respond orally.

D **In the DIALOG**, the learner sees and hears the appropriate vocabulary and sentence structure in natural-paced, informal conversation. The learner's task is to role-play the Dialog with a partner and go back and review vocabulary they don't understand.

CONVERSATION provides questions about commonplace topics. The learner's task is to practice using the vocabulary and sentence structure in everyday situations.

EVALUATION provides reinforcement in using basic function words, articles, verbs, prepositions, etc. The learner's task is to complete the evaluation and check their answers against the text of the Scene section.

The **TEST**, in the Appendix, provides an end-of-unit check. Completion of the **TESTS** is modeled in the first four Units of the video/DVDs. The learner's task is to review each section of the Unit until the test can be completed with fair accuracy.
