

FINDING Information

ODIN (Online Dakota Information Network) is a shared online catalog that includes resources owned by the BSC Library and many other North Dakota libraries. You can search ODIN without signing in, but signing in allows you to view your personal account information, renew items online, place requests for interlibrary loan, and more.

DATABASES (Articles & More)

The BSC Library subscribes to several multi-disciplinary databases. To access these resources from off-campus, you will be prompted to sign in.

BSC LIBRARY CARD

Your Key to Information

The BSC Library may be used by BSC students, faculty, staff, and other community users. A current library card is required to check out library materials or to access our databases from off-campus. Anyone is welcome to use library materials in the building.

For BSC students, faculty, and staff, **your BSC photo ID is your library card**. The library barcode number is on the back of the photo ID card.

To get your BSC photo ID or community library card, stop by the BSC Library during regular library hours.

- **BSC students and employees** must present proof of identification (e.g., driver's license) and official documentation of the EMPL # (Students: This is your W number).
- **North Dakota residents** have courtesy borrowing privileges at the library. Courtesy borrowers do not have interlibrary loan privileges. North Dakota residents must present a current North Dakota driver's license in order to get a borrower's card.
- **BSC distance education users (students and faculty)** may order a card online by visiting the Off-Campus Services section of the library Web site.



SIGN-IN Basics

To sign in to the ODIN catalog or databases, use your 14-digit library card number (barcode) and password (your last name; not case sensitive).

Example:

- Login: 23103000999999
- Password: yourlastname

LOAN Periods

General materials – 28 days
Media (DVDs, CDs, Videos) – 14 days
Reserve materials – Varies

Reference sources, BSC Archives materials, microfilm, magazines, journals, and newspapers do not circulate.

RENEWALS

Most general circulating materials can be renewed for two additional loan periods unless another borrower has requested them. Most items can be renewed online. You may also request renewals in person or by telephone.

FEES

Although we do not assess fines for overdue materials, we do expect materials to be returned on time and in good condition. When materials are three weeks late, they are considered lost and the borrower is billed. Library privileges are also suspended until the matter is resolved.

Failure to respond to notices about long overdue materials will result in collection action and holds on college records.

The per item fee for lost or damaged materials is the full replacement cost + a \$20 processing fee.
