
North Dakota Fishing Waters Map



North Dakota Fishing Waters (not including the Missouri River System)

The following includes most of the public fishing waters in North Dakota, listed alphabetically by county. If unsure of the location of a county or the code number, refer to the map on pages 50 and 51 which lists the county code numbers that coincide with this listing. Each lake listed includes travel directions, most common species present, boat motor restrictions (if any), season restrictions (if any), species restrictions (if any), bait restrictions (if any), dark house spear fishing (listed if allowed) and fishing piers (listed if present). Also listed are aeration systems if present. Use extreme caution when ice fishing on lakes with aeration systems. Lastly, most of North Dakota public fishing waters have a boat ramp (concrete and/or metal). If a boat ramp is lacking at a specific water body, it is listed as 'no ramp'.

Rivers And Others

Red River - Eastern edge of state. Entire length of the river, especially dams near Drayton, Grand Forks, Fargo, and Wahpeton. Tributaries such as Pembina, Forest, Turtle, and Wild Rice often good. (catfish, walleye, pike - specific restrictions for each species - ramps at Pembina, Drayton, GrandForks, near Buxton (Belmont Park), Fargo, Fort Abercrombie, Brush Vale bridge, and Wahpeton)

Souris River - North central part of state. Entire length of the river especially at dams associated with the Upper Souris and J. Clark Salyer refuges. (walleye, pike, perch)

Heart, Knife, Cannonball, and Cedar Rivers - Southwest part of state. Entire length of rivers, but especially at deep holes below dams, riffles and at mouths. (walleye, catfish, pike)

Sheyenne River - Southeastern part of state. Entire length of river especially below dams at Lisbon, Fort Ransom, near Kathryn, Cooperstown, Mill Dam, and Bald Hill Dam. (pike, catfish, walleye - catfish specific restrictions)

James River - Southeastern part of state. Entire length of river especially below dams at LaMoure, Jamestown, New Rockford, and west of Ludden. (pike, walleye)

Little Missouri River - Southwestern part of state. Entire length of river especially during and after high water. (catfish, sauger)

GDU Canal Lakes - includes New Johns (Burleigh Co), Heckers (Sheridan Co), and East and West Park (McLean Co) lakes - Nine miles south and three miles east and west of Mercer. (walleye, perch, largemouth bass)

McClusky Canal -(McLean, Burleigh, and Sheridan counties) - there are approximately 10 bridge crossings used for fishing between Lake Audubon and McClusky. (walleye, smallmouth bass, perch - no ramps)

Blumers Pond - One mile south of Valley City. (trout - no ramp)
Clausen Springs - Three miles north, 1 mile east, 1/2 mile north of the junction of Highways 46 & 1. (perch, largemouth bass - fishing pier, idle speed only, no live baitfish)
Eckelson Lake North - Two miles east of Eckelson. (perch - no ramp)
Fingal Dam - Eight miles west of Fingal. (pike, perch - no ramp)
Fox Lake - One mile west of Eckelson. (perch - no ramp)
Hatchery Kids Pond - Two miles northwest of Valley City. (trout - no ramp)
Hobart Lake North - Six miles west of Valley City. (perch - no ramp)
Kee Lake - Seven miles south, 2 miles east of Eckelson. (perch - no ramp)
Koebernick Pond - One mile north, 4 miles west, 1 mile north of Rogers. (perch - no ramp)
Lake Ashtabula - Ten miles north of Valley City. (pike, walleye, perch - fishing pier)
Meadow Lake - Six miles west, 6 miles north of Litchville. (perch - no ramp)

Moon Lake - Two miles west, 5 1/2 miles south, 4 miles west, 2 miles north of Valley City. (perch, smallmouth bass - trout restrictions)

Mosher WPA - Two and one-half miles north, 4 1/2 miles east of Dazey. (perch - no ramp)

Olson WPA - One and one-half miles east, 1/2 mile south of Sanborn. (perch - no ramp)

Peterson WPA - One and one-half miles east of Nome. (perch - no ramp)

Sanborn Lake - Two miles east of Sanborn. (perch - no ramp)

Sanborn WPA - One-half mile east of Sanborn. (perch - no ramp)

St Marys Lake - Two miles west, 5 1/2 miles south, 4 miles west, 1 mile north of Valley City. (perch - no ramp)

Sweetwater Lake - Four miles south, 1 mile east of Sanborn. (black crappie - no ramp)

Tenmile Lake - Seven miles east, 1/2 mile south of Wimbledon. (perch - no ramp)

(3) BENSON COUNTY

Silver Lake - One mile west, 6 miles south, 1 mile west, 1 mile north of Churchs Ferry. (pike, perch - no ramp, seasonal restrictions, dark house spear fishing)

Wood Lake - Two miles west, 1 mile south of Tokio. (pike, walleye, perch)

Carbury Dam - One mile south, 1 mile west of Carbury. (walleye, perch, bluegill - fishing pier, idle speed only) Lake Metigoshe - One mile east, 13 miles north, 2 miles east of Bottineau. (pike, walleye, perch - fishing pier) Long Lake - One mile east, 11 miles north, 4 miles east, 1 mile south, 3 miles east, 1 mile south, 1 mile west of Bottineau. Bowman-Haley Dam - Eleven miles south, 8 miles east, 2 miles south of Bowman. (walleye, perch, smallmouth bass - fishing pier)

Gascoyne Lake - One and one-half miles northwest of Gascoyne. (pike, perch, bluegill)

Kalina Dam - Two miles west, 1 mile south, 1 mile west, 1 mile south of Bowman. (pike, perch, bluegill - no ramp)

Lutz Dam - Two and one-half miles south, 2 miles west of Griffin. (trout, bluegill, largemouth bass - no ramp) Spring Lake - One mile south, 4 miles west of Rhame. (pike, perch)

(7) BURKE COUNTY

Northgate Dam - Six miles north, 1 mile west, 2 miles north, 1/2 mile west of Bowbells. (walleye, trout, bluegill - fishing pier)

Powers Lake - Southeast edge of Powers Lake. (pike, perch - fishing pier, dark house spear fishing)

Short Creek Dam - Five and one-half miles north of Columbus. (pike, perch, bluegill)

Smishek Dam - Four miles northwest of Powers Lake. (pike, walleye, perch - fishing pier)

(8) BURLEIGH COUNTY

Cottonwood Park Pond - South side of Bismarck. (trout - no ramp)

Fox Island Ponds - Fox Island Development of Bismarck. (largemouth bass - no ramp)

Lake Harriet (Arena Lake) - Eight miles west, 1 mile south of Tuttle. (pike, perch - no ramp)

Long Lake - Just east of Moffit. (pike, perch - no ramp, fishing pier, motor and seasonal restrictions, check with refuge headquarters for additional regulations)

McDowell Dam - Three and one-half miles east, 1 mile north of Bismarck-Highway 10. (trout, bluegill, largemouth bass - fishing pier, electric motors only, seasonal restrictions, trout restrictions, no live baitfish) Mitchell Lake - One mile west, 2 miles north of Wing. (pike, perch - fishing pier) Owls Pond - Just west of Game & Fish Office. (trout, perch, bluegill - no ramp, fishing pier, walking access only, open to fishing during daylight hours only) Twin Lakes - Seven miles west, 5 miles north of Tuttle.
