



## North Dakota Ground Water Dependant Noncommunity Public Water Systems

A public water system is defined as one which has at least 15 service connections or serves at least 25 people on a regular basis. Public water systems may be classified as "community" water systems or "non-community" water systems. Community water systems are typically cities, mobile home parks, or rural water systems. Non-community water systems may provide water to either a transient population (such as restaurants, campgrounds or truck stops) or a non-transient population (such as schools, manufacturing facilities, or power plants).
