

What services does my North Dakota State Library card entitle me?

Seven-day-a-week, 24-hour access to the following services:

- North Dakota State Library Online Catalog on the Internet
- More than 60 libraries in North Dakota through the Internet
- Full-text magazine and newspaper articles through the Internet
- Reference materials
- Electronic interlibrary loan requests
- Electronic holds on North Dakota State Library materials
- Electronic books (e-books)
- Electronic renewal of material borrowed from the North Dakota State Library
- Libraries in South Dakota and Minnesota through the Internet
- Your library record including items checked out to you, overdues, holds, and more

Who can receive a North Dakota State Library card?

Any permanent resident of North Dakota may receive a North Dakota State Library card at no charge.

How do I obtain a library card?

You can call the North Dakota State Library at 1-800-472-2104 or 328-4622 and request an application, or you can access an electronic form on the State Library home page at <http://ndsl.lib.state.nd.us>. A library card and password will be mailed to you.

If you are 18 or younger you must send a printed form signed by a parent or guardian to North Dakota State Library, 604 E. Boulevard Ave. Dept. 250, Bismarck, ND 58505-0800.

How do I receive materials?

Material is mailed to the address listed on your library record (except for the Bismarck-Mandan-Lincoln area). Bismarck-Mandan-Lincoln residents will pick up their material at the State Library.

What is my responsibility for items checked out on my library card?

- Return all materials
- Pay for lost or damaged materials
- Pay return postage

How many items can be checked out at one time?

- An individual patron may have up to 20 items
- A public or school library may have up to 200 items
