

PROGRAMS

The North Dakota State Library offers many unique programs for persons with physical, visual, and reading impairments.

- Dakota Radio Information Service (DRIS) provides daily broadcasts of local newspapers and special programming.
- The Talking Book Service provides talking books, magazines, and large print materials to North Dakota citizens who are unable to read standard print.



These programs are provided to patrons at *no charge*.

Services are provided with the help of *many dedicated volunteers* who donate their time so all may read.

VOLUNTEER POSITIONS

- *Radio Announcers* read newspapers, grocery ads, and feature articles for the DRIS broadcast.
- *Book and Magazine Narrators* record fiction and non-fiction books, North Dakota magazines, and other requested material.
- *Circulation Assistants* help State Library staff with daily circulation of talking books.
